Dr. Chisefu also had the opportunity to meet with Pastor Richard and Karen Farrand who are serving during 2019 as missionaries and deans at RICE, a Christian teacher's school outside of Lusaka in the Rafiki Village. Also Karen, who is a member and one of the teachers at FHG Bible Fellowship, wrote the questions for one of the courses they are taking. RiverCross is a global ministry whose mission is “to build bridges of hope so that vulnerable children can move from trauma-defined lives to thrive in life and trust in Christ.” May the Lord use Kim, her son Ethan, and the entire RiverCross team to bring healing and restoration to hearts and lives as they hold camps for children and as they train local leaders to be God’s

hands extended to help traumatized children in their own churches and villages cross the bridge to healing in Christ.

We are also blessed that another missionary heart besides Kim’s was stirred the day that Karen Farrand shared at FHGBF about the call to missions. The result? During the month of August, Recca Davis and her husband will also be serving the Lord in Zambia, but their service will be at the Rafiki Village assisting Karen and Richard Farrand. in the work they do at RICE in providing classical education for forty-seven Christian students who are preparing to become teachers in the Zambian schools.

Recca (*pictured right*) is one of the teachers at FHGBF and is also involved in prison ministry. She and her husband teach Sunday School in their home church and have served on the mission field in Central America. Most RBBC students are distance learners scattered throughout the nation of Zambia, but more students are desiring on-site learning. May the Lord guide their steps to the place He has chosen specifically for RBBC.
- **Better Life Bible College** will soon purchase a plot of land in the outskirts of Abuja, Nigeria, that will eventually house a classroom building. Currently meeting in a space too small for them, their hearts are rejoicing at God's provision.

We also celebrate with one of our spiritual advisors, **Dr. B. L. Rice and Shalom Ministry, Inc., for 40 years of faithful ministry** in the area of teaching God's Word, of raising up Bible colleges and ministers around the world and in the prisons. God has blessed us with many of the courses written by Dr. Rice and others at Shalom, with spiritual covering and mentorship, and with prayer and godly counsel. With heartfelt thanks for who they are in Christ, we pray for a release of God's overshadowing presence and power as they press on in this new season of anointed ministry.

It was in April 2019 that Dr. Kathy had the joy of meeting and having a time of prayer via What's App, with John Kariuki, who attends one of Dr. Tobias' churches in Kaburengu, Kenya. He was in the United States by invitation of the U.S. State Department because of his involvement in Kenya as a paramedic, first responder and advocate for orphans and the abused and traumatized. During his three weeks in the USA he was part of a team of 27 from nations around the world. They visited hospitals, rescue and trauma centers in many states in order to take additional skills and information back to their own countries. This surely was a strategic appointment orchestrated by God that will lead to more open doors for



ministry in his own nation of Kenya! God's hands extended through a willing vessel...may God continue to use and bless John as he serves the people of Kenya in Jesus' name!
