As the New Year dawned, so did the official beginning of *Better Life Bible College* as the third chartered School of Divinity under FHG Ministries & Bible College. Founded by Pastor Frank Ordu in 2013 in Abuja, Nigeria, classes were taught at the certificate and diploma levels, giving BLBC students a good biblical base for their continuing studies at the bachelor level as part of the FHG family of students. Pastor Frank continues to serve as BLBC President with an expectant heart for the unfolding of God's plans.

## Enter Not!!!

### Heed the Warnings of God

A devotional written by Earl, an incarcerated FHGBC bachelor student

*“Enter not into the path of the wicked, and go not in the way of evil men.”  
Proverbs 4:14*

When I drove the big semi-trucks, it did not matter if I drove them all across the country, or if it was just a short trip across town. I always had to know where it was that I was going and which path (route) that I was going to have to take to get there. I had to plan out which route would be the best one to take. This was especially true for the places where I had never been before. On the much longer trips, I would also have to plan where it was that I would stop for fuel and for all of my required breaks. For that purpose, we had what was called an “Exit Guide”. It was a book that would tell us at which exits we could stop with “Big Trucks”. Because of the size and weight of those big trucks, there would be a lot of places that had signs saying “NO TRUCKS ALLOWED”. Failure to obey these signs could lead to the loss of our driver’s license, our arrest or a large fine. They told us that we were not very welcome there and that we should “Enter Not”.

The books of Proverbs and Psalms act as road maps and exit guides. Verses like this one in Proverbs 4:14 and others like it in Psalms act as warning signs which tell us that we should not enter into that place. Failure to obey these signs will lead us into even greater consequences, like a truck driver ignoring those “NO TRUCKS” signs. Sometimes there were “NO TRUCK” signs posted because of a low overhead bridge or a bad section of road. These signs were for our own safety. Ignoring those signs got the drivers in a spot where they could not turn around or get out of the spot by themselves. Many times, it would require a tow truck to come and rescue them. To disobey or ignore the signs that God has given us also leads us into a spot where we cannot get out by ourselves. These are called the traps of Satan. It is at those times in life that we need to call upon Jesus to come and pull us out of the mess we got ourselves into. Ignorance is to ignore God’s warning signs and to disregard His roadmaps of life found in Proverbs and Psalms.



Let us pray... Lord Jesus, You are our rescuer from Satan’s many traps that he sets for us and that we seem to always get ourselves into because we do not follow Your ways. We ignore Your many signs and maps that you have drawn out for us in your books of Psalms and Proverbs. Also as our Lord, we ask that You have Your Holy Spirit give us what it takes to trust in those ways that You have given us. Have Him show us how to use those signs and plans that you have drawn out for us that we may safely get through life’s journey the best way possible and reach the destination of Your great Kingdom of Heaven. Let us learn, understand, and obey all of Your ways that we may no longer end up in Satan’s traps. Amen. 
