On December 1, 2017, the FHG Board hosted a retirement reception for friends, colleagues, students and graduates of FHGBC to celebrate and honor Dr. Beth Laurent for her twelve years of serving as president of FHG Bible College. Her husband, Frank, was also honored for his ministry as college treasurer.

After being a vital part of FHGBC since its inception in 2000, Dr. Beth became the second president of the college on January 1, 2006. Under her 12 years of leadership, the college prison outreach grew and greatly touched incarcerated men and women in Wisconsin and other states with God's love and life-changing Word. Her background as a social worker for 23 years and, more importantly, her heart for the Lord, His Word and His people, were qualities that helped to bring birth the FHGBC Biblical Counseling Department, which has been a part of training lay counselors in biblical truths. Countless hearts, lives, and marriages have been have changed as a result.

Fruit that remains is surely part of the legacy of Dr. Beth Laurent! Whether in the classroom, office or on the mission field, her loving and firm application of God's Word has touched many hearts and lives. The anointed words she spoke through her biblical teaching, counseling, and through the courses she wrote will continue to ring true in the hearts of students at FHGBC and in our African colleges for years to come. **We are forever grateful for her faithful and diligent service to the Lord!**

Her Christian ministry will never stop, and we rejoice that she and Frank will remain on the FHG Board of Directors and will be available to serve the college and ministry as the Lord leads, including FHGBC graduation in June. For His Glory Bible Fellowship Winter 2018 Studies Shallotte, NC





Hellen N. Sitanda Translated To Glory During Church Service ***January 19, 1973 to January 14, 2018***

In the early morning hours of Sunday, January 14, 2018, Sister Hellen Nasimiyu Sitanda rose to attend the 4 a.m. prayer meeting at Dispensation of Grace Church right next to her home. This was part of her life, heart and ministry to the Lord and for the people of the church she co-founded with her husband, Dr. Tobias Sitanda Wakhungu. That morning her prayers and intercession joined with those of others at the meeting and ascended before God's throne of grace. She returned home and fixed breakfast and then went back to church for morning worship and service.



According to Dr. Tobias, "It was on 14th January 2018, at 11:40 am. My wife of 24 years stood to testify and encourage the Church. Little did we realize that was going to be her last Sunday service on earth. Hellen had been well but after she finished her testimony and exhortation, she was translated to glory!"

Hellen was part of the vision team that was instrumental in the formation of Dispensation of Grace Ministries as well as The Word of Truth Bible College. As co-founder with her husband, Dr. Tobias Wakhungu, she served on the Executive Board of the college and helped to bring it to birth and sustain it through her undergirding of prayer and her godly counsel as a WOTBC board member.

"A dear wife, friend, confidant and companion" to Dr. Tobias, Hellen was also mother to their three children – Bruno, Faith, and Marion. She helped to farm their land and served her family, neighbors, church and college to the glory of God.

In addition, in 2016 Hellen earned a Diploma in Biblical Studies at WOTBC and went on into her bachelor studies. Having earned over the required 126 credits, she will be awarded the Bachelor of Divinity Degree posthumously at the next college graduation. What a privilege to honor her for her years of faithful ministry and study at the college she co-founded!

On the day her body was returned to her home before burial, WOTBC students, staff and graduates were lined up to receive and honor her. Waiting at their home were about 300 additional people, and several days later at her burial and funeral there were over 500 gathered as testimony, preaching, and praises to God went forth in celebration of Hellen's life.



Hellen had a strong and deep faith that saw her through difficult times and she is an example of a life lived for the glory of the Lord. She will be greatly missed and remembered with much love and affection, and we know that much fruit will remain as a result of her faithfulness and loving Christian service. Our sincere sympathies go to Dr. Tobias, Bruno, Faith and Marion (*pictured right*) and to all whose hearts were touched by Hellen's life.



We also extend our deep sympathies to Dr. Tobias and family in the loss last week of his 84-year old mother, Susan, who is now forever with the Lord. May the Lord strengthen and comfort you with His abiding presence in Jesus' name, amen.

A New Season of Communication: Teaching Videos from FHG with Love!

After showing the video, the instructor then can add his or her own teaching and open it up for discussion or questions. At that point, a short teaching video to address the biblical question can be made to give the instructor a greater understanding of the issue or for the instructor to use in the midst of the classroom teaching.
